## WHAT IS IMPROPER CONDUCT?

Improper conduct includes behaviours or actions relating to public administration that are either:

- corrupt
- against the law
- dishonest
- inappropriate
- or not in the best interests of Territorians.

The Independent Commissioner Against Corruption (ICAC) can investigate or refer alleged improper conduct relating to public administration.

The ICAC also provides education resources, information sessions and training to help prevent improper conduct.
