

Report improper conduct for a better Territory

On International Anti-Corruption Day, the Office of the Commissioner Against Corruption (ICAC) supports the message of Transparency International:

International Anti-Corruption Day is an opportunity to remember the overwhelming global consensus against corruption and the global promise to work together to stop it.

We can only tackle corruption by working together. We need to collectively call for a world in which governments are accountable to the people, in which the practices of business and industry are sensitive to the social and environmental footprint of their actions, and in which community organisations genuinely and fairly serve the people they represent.

The ICAC has called on Territorians to report improper conduct to promote the integrity of NT public administration.

People who report a reasonable suspicion of improper conduct to the Office of the ICAC are protected by law, and all reasonable suspicions reported to the ICAC are carefully assessed.

The Office of the ICAC has received more than 450 reports of improper conduct since the commencement of the *Independent Commissioner Against Corruption Act*. More than 40 ICAC investigations are currently underway and dozens more matters have been referred to public agencies for investigation, some of which are being oversighted by the ICAC.

The Territory's reputation as an excellent place to live, work and invest is closely linked with the integrity of the jurisdiction.

Unfortunately, the actions of a few have the potential to damage the reputation of many, and that's why the majority of hardworking and honest Territorians must report improper conduct when they see it.
